- The terrible earthquake of the seventh plague will destroy all the cities of the world.
- The coming of Christ amid the flames of fire will complete the destruction. 2 Thessalonians 1:7, 8.

11. What will the saints (redeemed ones) do in heaven? Revelation 20:4.

- They will evaluate the punishment that the wicked deserve. 1 Corinthians 6:2, 3.
- God's justice will be vindicated through the participation of the saints in the judgment.
