- How was the Bible inspired? The prophets were God's instruments, who wrote down the thoughts He placed in their minds.

EVIDENCE OF ITS DIVINE ORIGIN

1. TEXTUAL EVIDENCE

- A) The unity of its message. Despite having been written by almost 40 authors throughout a period of 1,600 years (1500 B.C. A.D. 100); and by persons of the most varied social positions: kings, generals, a prime minister, doctors, shepherds, fishermen, prophets, etc., it contains one united message.
- B) Conservation of its writings. Numerous ancient manuscripts that have been found, such as the ancient writings of Qumran near the Dead Sea, which date back to the first and second centuries B.C., show that the original text has been preserved intact throughout the centuries.

2. HISTORICAL EVIDENCE PROVEN BY ARCHEOLOGY

Numerous excavations in the Middle East marvelously confirm the Biblical accounts. Cities like Lachish, Hazor,
Megiddo, Nineveh, and many others, whose
locations were unknown, have been unearthed.
 Some 2,500 biblical places have been identified.

3. PROPHETIC EVIDENCE

The Bible has some 2,300 prophecies that reveal the future; and these prophecies have continually been confirmed by history. For example, prophecies regarding:

- Cities, towns, nations, and kingdoms.
- World and ecclesiastical history.
- The life of men, mentioned before their birth.

- Events with accurate detail, including time, year and day.
- Discoveries of our century that were mentioned millennia ago.
- With many details, it describes current events that show us that we are living at the end of earth's history.

Prophecy helps us understand God's timing and helps us understand the time that we are living in.

Prophecies that have been fulfilled, give us certainty in the future fulfillment of prophecies regarding globalization, economy, the new political world order, and the great divine solution to our human problems.

4. CHRIST, THE GREATEST EVIDENCE

Centuries before His birth, 333 prophecies regarding the details of His life were written; and these prophecies, which were wonderfully fulfilled, are recorded in the Gospels. The greatest evidence of His Divinity is found in His life, death, and resurrection; but the most important is that He came to earth to reveal God to humanity.

"He that hath seen me hath seen the Father." John 14:9. He has shown us:

- His love: "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." John 3:16.
- His protective care: "Fear thou not; for I am with thee: Be not dismayed; for I am thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness." Isaiah 41:10.
- His great and complete forgiveness: "Who is a God like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of his heritage?... Because He delighteth in mercy...He will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea." Micah 7:18, 19.
- His plan for the eternal happiness of man. The thousands of promises found in the Bible are the constant encouragement we need to face the future with hope.
